Board meeting March 21, 2006

- **Review of the Minutes:** There were some items that needed to be changed regarding the minutes. Sunday May 7th, try outs are at Milwaukie High school, and the following weeknights are at Meldrum Bar Park. Also Greg Hess is the Representative for Gladstone Soccer Club.
 - Gordon made a motion, seconded by Diane, to approve the minutes with the above stated changes. *Passed unanimously*

- **Mass Mailer** from Thelo United Futbol Club, to the data base of our three “base” clubs, will include: Tryout schedule, Player & Parent letter and Registration Form. Discussion followed regarding players wishing to play up. Players will be encouraged to play at their own age level but there will be a process in which we can evaluate on an individual basis. A player must try out at every level they wish to play. They will only be considered for age levels they had tried out for. U-12 and U-13 times were traded so players who want to try out at more than 1 level could.
 - **Someone** need to reword “Refunds” to state that any refund would be minus fees already paid out on behalf of their child. No refunds after June10,2006
 - **Add** Cell phone numbers to registration form
 - **Add** “primary contact” to registration form

- **How will coaches** contact players after tryouts? *Tabled until another time*

- **Financial Report:** \$1120.70 in existing MGU account. Based on 2005 expected expenses to start up the year is about \$200-\$300.

- Diane made a motion, seconded by Gordon, to purchase labels from OYSA to pick and choose from, not to exceed \$87. *Passed unanimously*

- Gordon made a motion, seconded by Debbie, To develop a postcard for Thelo tryouts that we could send to the names obtained by OYSA.
 - Passed unanimously*

- **Goal Lines** is one way to get the word out regarding Thelo United Futbol. It is kind of expensive but has a broad reading. Kent is willing to place an add in the “Gold Saver” for our tryouts, at no charge. He just asks that we find out from our participants where they found out about the tryout.

- Gordon made a motion, seconded by Debbie, to get thelounited.org as our website address. Also to purchase thelounited.com as well. *Passed unanimously*

- **Logo:** Jim presented some ideas regarding a club logo. Some of the discussion was that “threes” seemed to go along with strength, want and desire. More ideas were discussed regarding coloring, shape and the number of colors. We need to keep in mind the cost when picking colors.
- **By Laws** were tabled until next time.
- **Parents meeting** before try out to answer questions. Many were brought up at the coaches meeting and it was felt parents probably had some of the same concerns. What will this meeting look like? This should be included on postcard.

 - also Sunday April 23rd.
- **Signs:** A motion by Karen, seconded by Gordon, to have 4 Thelo try out signs made for the Middle Schools for an approximate cost of \$200.

Passed unanimously. Debbie will have the tryout signs made.
- **Thelo United Football** is asking the Club Representatives to go to their club board and find out what they may be willing to donate regarding “start up”. Start up includes, but would not be exclusive to, new signs, starting up web site and additional mailing costs.
